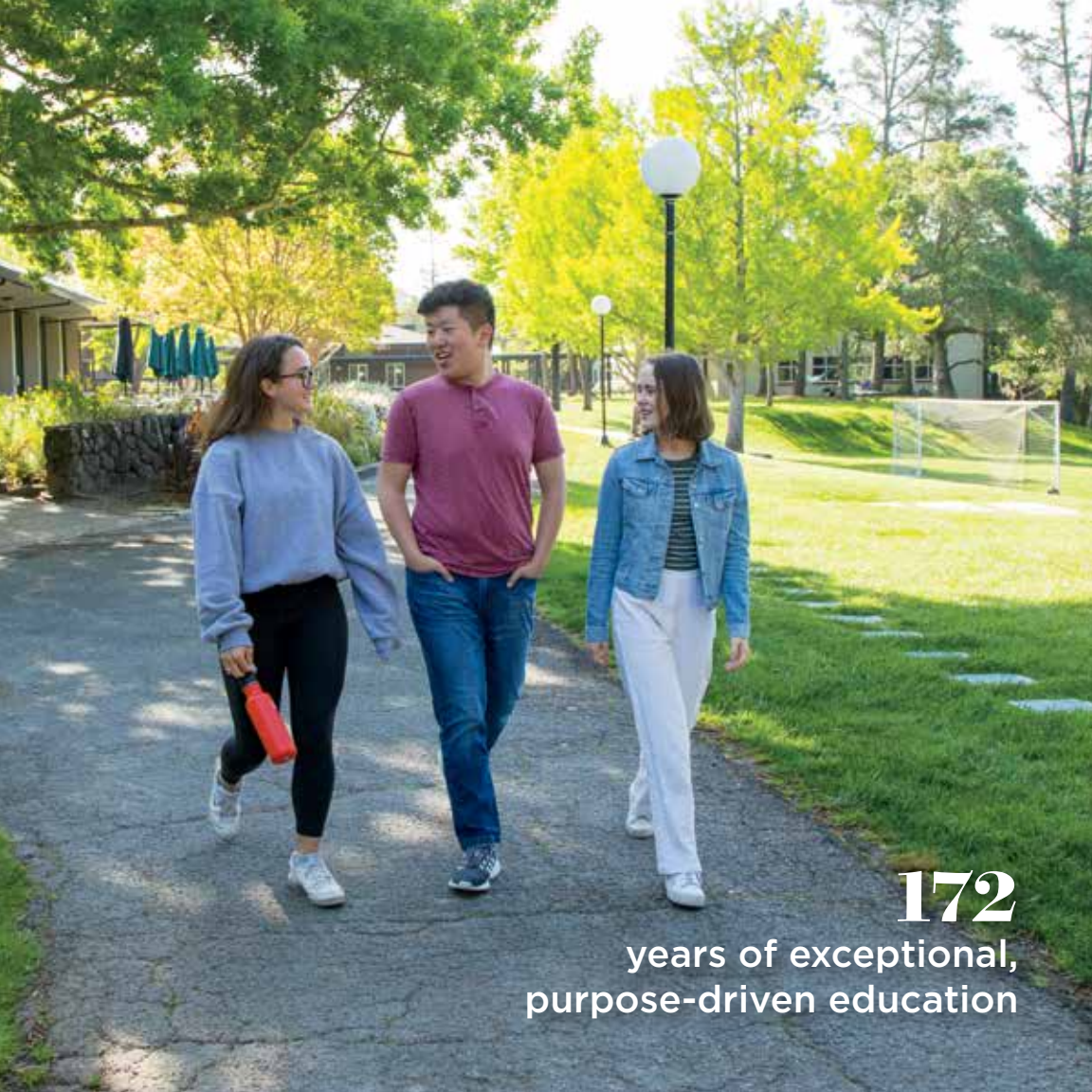


FACTS AT A GLANCE

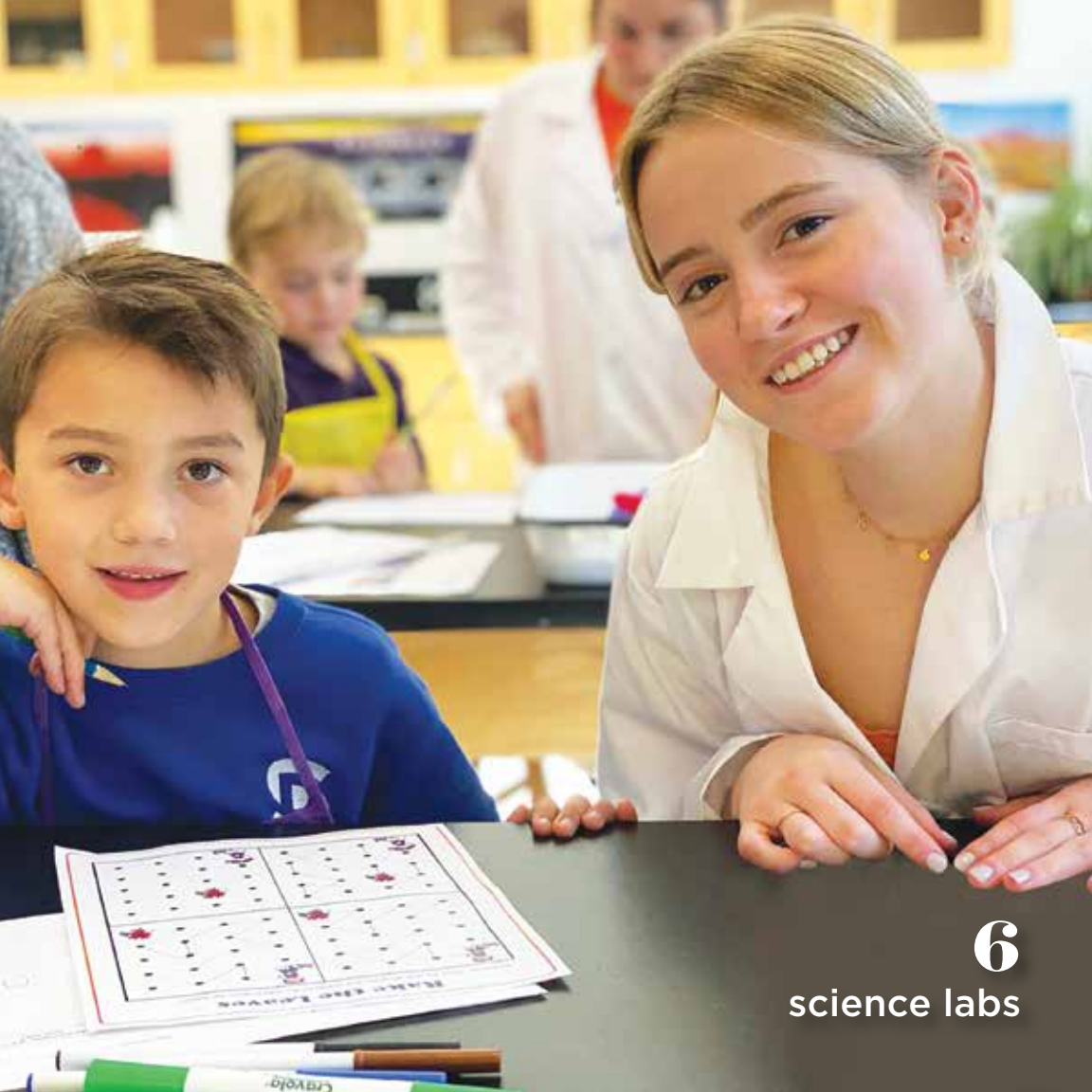
